
Prompt Sheet

This equipment should only be used by Competent Persons, who have been trained in the use of this specific kit.

These Prompt Sheets are to be read in conjunction with user instructions for each item of the kit.

Lowering

- Select an unquestionably sound anchorage structure, above casualty.
- Pass anchor strop (A) around anchorage and connect karabiner to screwlink
- Fit open hook to end of pole. With control device in "go" position detent, extend rope and pole to casualty (B).
 Attach hook to harness and pull to release, ensuring hook gate closes fully.
- 4. Lock handle and hauling catch (D).
- Pull rope to casualty tight by pulling tail end through device (C).
- Check all connections, then cut casualty's fall arrest lanyard, with shears.
- Remove the 'lock-off and gently lower casualty by holding tail rope and squeezing device handle into 'sweet spot' (E).





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Prompt Sheet

This equipment should only be used by competent persons, who have been trained in the use of this specific kit.

These user instructions are to be read in conjunction with user instructions for each item of the kit.

Raising

- Select an unquestionably sound anchorage structure, above casualty.
- Pass anchor strop (A) around anchorage and connect karabiner to screwlink.
- Fit open hook to end of pole. With control device in "go" position detent, extend rope and pole to casualty (B). Attach hook to harness and pull to release, ensuring hook gate closes fully.
- 4. Lock handle and hauling catch (D).
- Pull rope to casualty tight by pulling tail end through device (C).
- Attach Hurricane to casualty rope as shown (E). DO NOT PUT DEVICE OVER EDGE
- 7. To raise casualty, pull tail rope (F).
- 8. When hauling-device reaches control-device, slide hauling-device back down rope.
- Repeat steps 6 & 7 to incrementally raise casualty as required.







Assembly

- Feed rope complete with modified scaffhook attached, into KARI bag. Scaffhook end at top!
- 2. Place Xtendr Rescue Reach pole in bag (bubble wrap around bracket end to protect bag), attach shears and pouch to pole karabiner with alloy Altair karabiner.
- 3. Thread RescueHauler on to rope following diagram marked on device/ pictures in file. RescueHauler should be approx. 50cm from scaffhook end of rope.
- 4. Attach protected sling to RescueHauler using screwlink, hand tighten screwlink. Ensure non-sewn end of sling is attached to screwlink. Captivate steel karabiner to other end of sling (stitched end) by installing pin through karabiner clean end first and gently hammering until flush.
- 5. Attach Hurricane onto rope around pulley wheel, close and latch front plate.
- 6. Fill out details on Tyvek Kit Card (Product- WK31XXX, Model Type -RescueHauler+ Length, Manufacture Date - Date assembled), and place into front pocket of bag with RESCUE on outside. Place these Instructions and Prompt Sheet inside the KARI bag, then finally roll down top, minimum three turns and clip to side buckles and adjust until firm.

Disclaimer: It is the users responsibility to assemble the kit correctly referring to individual product user instructions.

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
